## From the North or South (take I-95 to I-695)

- Take exit 16-16A-16B to merge onto I-70 W to MD-97N to Howard County
- Take exit 76 from I-70W to merge onto MD-97N toward Westminster
- Continue on MD-97 N, turn right onto W Obrecht Rd, turn left onto White Rock Rd, Turn Right onto Martz Rd to destination:

**30 Martz Road, Sykesville, MD 21784**

**Entrance Fees: Carroll County residents \$6/per vehicle; out-of-county residents \$12/per vehicle, Seniors 62 or older, Military personnel and Veterans are admitted FREE.**

Pavilion #1 accommodates 250 people and has a partial view of Piney Run Lake. This pavilion is located near a basketball court, tennis court and restroom. Pavilion #1 is not ADA accessible. All pavilions have electricity. This pavilion includes 2 large grills and 24 8ft tables. You must bring your own charcoal. You may bring your own grill if you wish.

### Park Rules and Restrictions:

- Alcohol is permitted, however public intoxication will not be tolerated and drinks must remain in the pavilion
- There is no amplification allowed at Piney Run Park. This includes stereos, DJ equipment, speakers and microphones
- No carnival type booths such as dunking booths, moon bounces, outside vendors etc. are allowed
- Dogs are welcome at county parks, but must be kept on a leash at all times. Clean up after your pet at all parks.
- Parking is permitted in designated areas only.
- Feeding or harassing wildlife is prohibited.
- Consistent with our goal of supporting a strong, healthy community and natural environment, Carroll County Parks are tobacco-free facilities, including vapes. We thank you for your voluntary cooperation.
- Visitors are expected to carry out the trash they generate and dispose of it properly at home or at another appropriate destination. Each Pavilion has trash cans and recycling bins available for your use. Park staff will empty trash and recycling containers. Do not empty ashes into trash cans, recycling bins, or onto the ground.
- **Pavilions MUST be cleaned and vacated by time indicated at the pavilion.**
